WHEREAS, America's Center for Foreign Investment (ACFI) was established on July 5, 2006, to participate in the EB-5 Immigrant Investor Visa Job-creation Program, also known as the EB-5 Program, administered by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services of the Department of Homeland Security; and

WHEREAS, ACFI is a federally approved regional center which allows it to initiate job-creating capital investment projects in Alabama and its four sister states and attract foreign investors' capital to create good jobs that pay well for Alabama workers; and

WHEREAS, ACFI is an EB-5 Compliance Consulting Services Company, the first such company approved by United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to operate as a regional center; and

WHEREAS, ACFI discharges its duties and obligations in accordance with the EB-5 program and focuses on identifying capital development projects in growth industries and in rural areas of Alabama to create jobs; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 370 regional centers in the United States, but ACFI is among the most active; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature of the State of Alabama hereby commends the Alabama Center for Foreign Investment for its focus on creating good jobs for Alabama workers.
